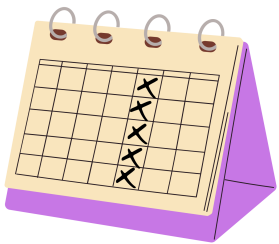


Peer Mentor

Job Description

	Attend the course You will attend every session, each week of the course. Courses are either online or in person.
	Welcoming members You will welcome members as they arrive. You will introduce members to each other. You will support them to feel comfortable and relaxed. You will help create a safe space. This will encourage them to participate.
	Support the Course Facilitators You will make sure everyone gets a chance to speak. You may lead small group activities or group discussions.

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	You may wish to share your relevant experiences with the group.
	Training and support You will take part in Peer Mentor support sessions. You will take part in relevant training. We will support you to do your job well and learn new skills.
	Working with colleagues You will work with your colleagues and members of get2gether in a way that respects difference and individual choices.

You should use it to help you decide if you want to apply and to help you fill in the application form.

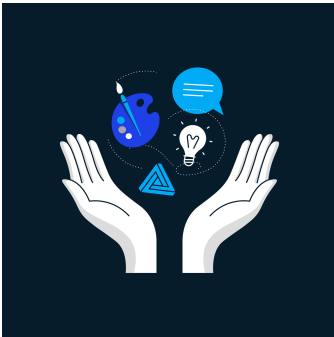
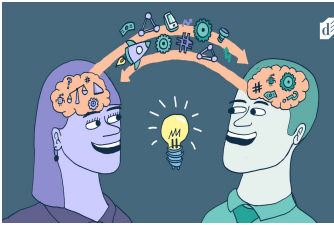
Essential

	Values & attitudes You believe that everyone is entitled to love and friendship. You believe in equality. You want to learn. You want to work. You know the importance of avoiding harmful or offensive language.
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	Skills You are welcoming and know how to make people feel safe and included. You are a good listener. You are good at encouraging and supporting other people's learning. You are good at self-reflection. You are aware of your personal boundaries. You can share your relevant experiences without taking up too much space. You can work online and on Zoom.
	Knowledge and Understanding You understand what it is like to have a label of disability. You have attended either the Live Your Life course or the Let's Talk About Sex course. You understand the topics on these courses and are interested in them.

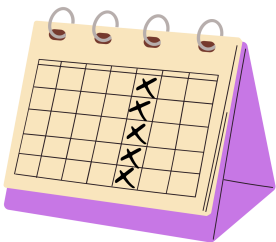
	You may have experience of public-speaking. You may have experience of leading group discussions.
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Further Information

	We run a number of courses across the year. You will be expected to work as a Peer Mentor on one or more courses each year.
	You will be expected to attend regular peer support sessions to learn from other Peer Mentors and support each other's development.
	The hours of work will depend on if you are attending a course.

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You will be paid £10.40 per hour.

You will get the equivalent of 6 weeks **annual leave** each year, depending on how many hours you work.

This post is **fixed term** and dependent on funding being secured.

Annual Leave	Paid time-off.
Attitudes	An opinion or behaviour about something.
Colleagues	A co-worker, a person you work with.
Course Facilitators	People that lead our courses.
Encouraging	To give hope, courage and confidence.
Equality	The belief that people should be treated equally.
Facilitate	To assist and guide people.
Fixed Term	A contract where you work for a specific period of time. Renewal of contract will depend on getting funding.

Group Discussions	Talking about a topic with other people.
Let's Talk About Sex	get2gether's course on building healthy relationships. We talk about sex, relationships, pleasure, friendships and much more.
Live Your Life	get2gether's wellbeing course. We help people live the life they want to live.
Members	People with lived experience of disability who have signed up for get2gether.
Participate	To take part.
Personal Boundaries	Guidelines, rules or limits that a person can set with other people in their life to make sure they are safe and have healthy relationships.
Person Specification	A list of the skills, knowledge and qualities needed for the job.
Public-speaking	Speaking in front of a group/ to an audience.

Relevant experiences	Things that have happened in your life which may be worth sharing to a group of people as a learning opportunity.
Relevant Training	The teaching of skills and knowledge that will help you with your job at get2gether.
Self-reflection	Looking back on your thoughts, feelings and behaviours. This helps you to grow and learn
Support Session	Support sessions are meetings with the course facilitator(s) and other peer mentors. These meetings are to check in on how you are getting on with your role and your wellbeing.
Values	The way you live your life to decide what is right and what is wrong.
Zoom	A video meeting platform. We will hold some of our courses on Zoom and Peer Mentor Support Sessions on Zoom.
